NON-REGULAR CLASSES & SPECIAL AWARDS - DESCRIPTIONS

The regular breed judge, after Best in Breed is completed, will judge the "Best" Awards Best Puppy: The winners of the 6-9 dog/bitch classes, the 9-12 dog/bitch classes and the Bred-By Exhibitor Puppy dog/bitch classes will compete for Best Puppy unless directly or indirectly defeated; i.e., the dog goes Best of Winners, he would also get Best Puppy.

Best Bred-By: The winners of the Bred-By Exhibitor puppy & adult classes, both dog and bitch, will compete for Best Bred-By Exhibitor. If Best of Breed or Best of Winners is from one of the Bred-By Exhibitor Classes, it is automatically the Best Bred-By Exhibitor.

Best Veteran: The winners of the Veteran dog/bitch classes will compete for Best Veteran. If Best of Breed is from one of the Veteran Classes, it is automatically the Best Veteran.

Field Trial Classes: For those dogs and bitches who have a placement in the Senior Stakes (example – Gun Dog or All Age) or a first in Derby Stakes at an AKC Licensed Field Trial <u>or</u> an **English Setter** with AKC Junior Hunter, Senior Hunter or Master Hunter titles <u>or</u> ESAA Hunting Dog Hunting Excellence titles, as confirmed by ESAA HD Test Chairman.

Awards of Merit: The judge at his/her discretion, may present up to three (3) Awards of Merit. KMESC allows for one (1) Award of Merit per ten (10) exhibits in the BOB competition to be presented in addition to Best of Breed, Best Opposite Sex, Best of Winners and Grand Champion Dog and Grand Champion Bitch.

PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES – SATURDAY & SUNDAY

Puppy Sweepstakes is open to all English Setters 6 months of age and under 18 months of age on the day of the show. All entries in Puppy Sweepstakes must be entered in one of the regular classes at the regular class entry fee. Champions of Record are allowed to compete. Sweepstakes class and age division must be indicated on the entry form under additional classes.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP - SATURDAY & SUNDAY

(Note: additional information required on back of entry form)

NOVICE CLASS: This class shall be for boys and girls, who at the time entries close, have not won three first places, with competition present, in a Novice class at a licensed or member show.

Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition present after the closing of entries for a show are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Superintendent or Show Secretary at least one-half hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show.

<u>OPEN CLASS</u>: This class shall be for boys and girls who have won three first place awards in a Novice class in a licensed or member show, with competition present. The winner of a Novice Class shall automatically become eligible, upon notice to the Open Class ring steward, to enter and compete in the Open Class at the same show provided the win is the 3rd first place award with competition and further providing there are one or more junior handlers competing in the Open Class.

MASTER CLASS: This class shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 first place wins in an Open class with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will be November 1 – October 31 of the following year. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed, all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

The Novice and Open Classes will be divided into **Junior**, **Intermediate and Senior** divisions. The **Junior** class is for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show. The **Intermediate** class shall be for the boys and girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years on the day of the show.

The Senior class shall be for boys and girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show.

NATIONAL OWNER-HANDLED SERIES - SATURDAY & SUNDAY

The AKC Owner/Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers. *Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay or received payment for handling a dog within the last five years

- Professional handlers, household members & current assistants to professional handlers may not exhibit (see definition above of a professional handler). A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis or assisting a professional handler at the show or any show during the cluster/weekend.
- Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner/Handled eligible at the time of entry using the check box on the entry form.
- > The handler must be an owner of record according to the AKC's records as of the date of the show.
- Dogs declared eligible will be identified by an asterisk or other representative mark in the steward's book, in the show catalog and in the judge's book.
- Dogs must be handled by an eligible owner-handler eligible for the AKC National Owner-Handled Series through the breed level competition for the regular show. This includes the class competition & subsequent competition in the breed ring. Additionally, dogs must be handled by an eligible owner/handler for all AKC National Owner-Handled Series competition.
- The Owner/Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the eligible dogs that competed in the Best of Breed/Variety competition for the regular show. This includes Winners Dog, Winners Bitch and the undefeated winners of the non-regular classes. This excludes all dogs defeated during class & winners competition for the regular show.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS - PLEASE READ!

SHOW SITE will be available to exhibitors from 3:00 - 10:00 P.M. CDT on Friday, June 23, 2023

•NO ENTRY SHALL be made or accepted which specifies any condition to its acceptance.

•ENTRIES SHALL NOT be accepted without signature and fees. All entries must be on official AKC entry forms.
 •ENTRY FEES shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts, including extreme weather conditions, beyond the control of the management; it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry shall be made. Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to snow storms, hurricanes, lightening, extreme heat, heavy rains, or other circumstances including, but not limited to, the condition of the facilities or grounds and/or the ingress and egress from the grounds, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance and, in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the show before completion, no refund of entry fee with be made.
 •POST-DATED CHECKS AND RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. The KMESC will add a collection fee of \$25 to the amount of each returned check. If acknowledgement of entry is not received by exhibitor within a reasonable period of time, please notify the show secretary.

•NO REFUND FOR DUPLICATE ENTRIES. Every effort to find all duplicate entries will be made; however, if entry has been processed, no refund will be made. ERRORS ON ENTRY FORMS. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

•DOGS MAY ARRIVE any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.

•NO SMOKING IN BUILDING.

•NO PRIVATE exercise pens in the building. Grooming allowed in designated areas only.

•EXHIBITORS must exercise their dogs in the designated areas and pick up after them.

•JUDGES WILL NOT WAIT FOR ANY DOG HOLDING UP A CLASS. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged.

•ALL DOGS PRESENT must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged.

(Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).

2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e, age division, color division, weight division.

4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)

5. Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
