- No blaster-type hair dryers allowed after judging commences in indoor grooming areas with a show ring (EAST HALL) - handheld, low force dryers are okay.

All Royal Canin prizes, if not presented in the ring, must be picked up during the event at the Royal Canin booth. Presentation of the winning ribbon is required. Royal Canin reserves the right to make prize substitutions of equal or greater value in the event a specific listed prize is not available

It is also understood that each club associated with the Waukesha Summer Splash Shows reserves the right to substitute any unavailable prize(s) with one(s) of equal or greater value. Prizes must be claimed the day of the show(s). None will be mailed. Unclaimed prizes will become property of the club which offered said prize.

NOTE: In order to comply with the provisions of Wisconsin Statutes [s. 95.21 (2)] and Administrative Codes [s. ATCP 11.52], relating to the Statewide Rabies Control Program, the owner of any dog kept or exhibited in Wisconsin (other than a dog kept for educational or scientific purposes) shall have the dog vaccinated against rabies by a veterinarian at no later than 5 months of age and revaccinated within one year after the initial vaccination. Any person (including out-of-state exhibitors) who imports a dog into Wisconsin (for exhibition or any other purpose) must have a valid interstate health certificate or certificate of veterinary inspection for that dog, regardless of the age of the dog. The certificate must be completed by a veterinarian; accompany the dog when it enters this state; and indicate the current vaccination status of the dog. Vaccinations shall be administered by a veterinarian and comply with age and time standards and label instructions approved by the federal bureau for the type of vaccine used. Additional information regarding these regulations may be obtained from the Wisconsin State Veterinarian at (608) 224-4888.

EXPO RULES AND RV GUIDELINES

THESE RULES WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED. Anyone who either ignores the directions of the Parks staff at the gate or bypasses them in some manner will be subject to an Event Committee Hearing, per the Waukesha Kennel Club, Inc.

- The only vehicles allowed within the show area (within 50' of all rings), are First Aid, Security, Expo Staff, and Waukesha Kennel Club, Inc. dog show staff. All private golf carts, utility vehicles, and ATVs must be used around the outer perimeter of the event.
- Day RV Camping ONLY in Gate #1. No overnight parking will be allowed. Anyone who chooses not to abide by this rule will be asked to move their RV to the overnight RV camping area through Gate #3 and will be required to pay the appropriate overnight fees. Noncompliance will result in your RV being towed at your expense.
- Entrance to RV Camping is Gate #3. Upon arrival to Gate #3, participants will need to provide a copy of their registration confirmation. Once registration has been verified, an admission pass will be provided to be displayed in the window of the RV. Access to Gate #3 is limited to:
 - o Recreational vehicles with proper admission pass displayed. One extra vehicle per RV site. Mirror hanger provided for the extra vehicle.

- After 10:00 P.M., RVs are welcome to enter Gate #3 to be staged in Arena West Parking Lot until the next morning. No electrical hookups available. Wednesday arrivals are welcome from 3:00 P.M. until 10:00 P.M. and Thursday - Saturday 6:00 A.M. until 10:00 P.M.
- A noise curfew is in effect from 10:00 P.M. until sunrise. This applies to all types of loud noises, including, but not limited to, music and stereos. Please be considerate of your neighbors so everyone can have a pleasant time.
- Grills are allowed by individual RV sites only, not on the show grounds. Hot coals should not be dumped into Expo trash containers or dumpsters. Absolutely NO campfires of any kind are allowed.
- No tent camping will be allowed.
- All dogs must be kept on a 6 feet or less leash, unless in designated dog show rings.

No Entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

Entry Fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee. If because of riots, wars, strikes, civil disturbances, national emergencies, health emergencies, and the dictates of law enforcement or of the owner(s) of the grounds and/or facilities or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or to complete the event, no refund of entry fee will be made. All Dogs Present must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising ring.

Class Cash Prizes will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging of that breed is over, and the Superintendent's Office advised at once. The Superintendent and Show-Giving Club disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the breed is over.

No gasoline or diesel generators are permitted inside any building or within 100 feet of any tent in which this dog show is conducted.
